Nicole has helped raise over \$16 million for diabetes research. In 2005, she was named the first Ambassador for the International Diabetes Federation’s Life for a Child Program, which advocates for children with diabetes in developing countries around the world.

Another inspirational speaker is Douglas Cairns, the author of Dare to Dream. Douglas, who has Type 1 diabetes, flew his own aircraft around the world. His remarkable story looks at his life as a young RAF (Royal Air Force) flight officer who acquired diabetes overnight, and what he learned about people affected with diabetes the world over.
